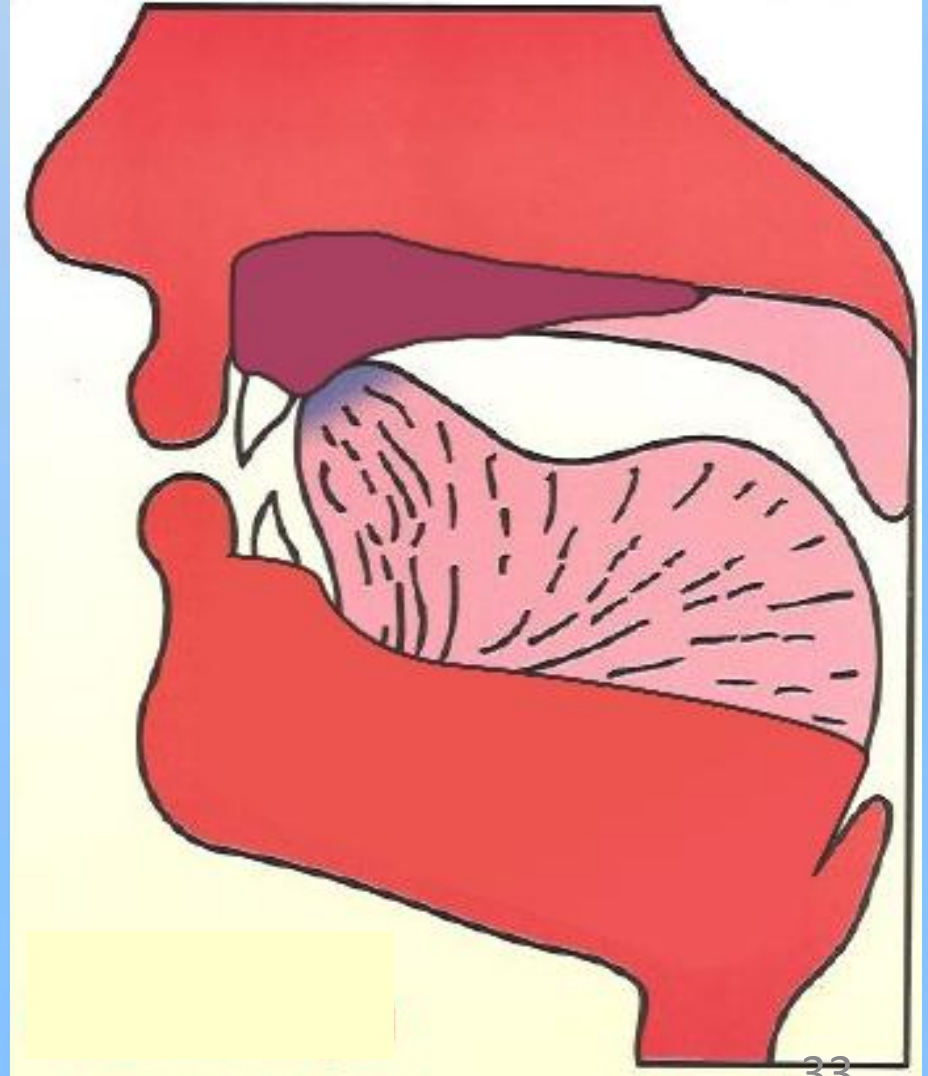

**Touch the tip of the tongue to the upper gums
above the roots of the teeth.**



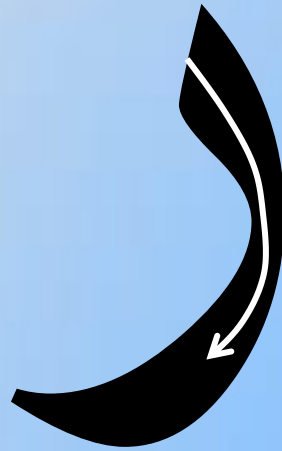
ر is too thin and small. (just like وِدْ and ز)

It has no wide face.

Therefore, it has no short form. It has full form only.

Thin letter → No connector after it.
