

In this lesson, we will learn Three states of Nasb: (1) object; (2) for emphasis; and (3) to denote the reason.

➤ Remember this example:

Why?	The same? (emphasis)	Who?
طَاعَةً	ذِكْرًا	اللَّهِ
in obedience (to Him)	remembrance	Allah
		I remembered

➤ Let us take additional examples for each of the above three cases.

1. Examples from the Qur'an for: **Who / What?** (object).

خَلَقَ اللَّهُ الْأَرْضَ

Allah created the earth

يَضْرِبُ اللَّهُ الْأَمْثَالَ لِلنَّاسِ

And Allah presents examples for the people

وَلَا تَقْتُلُوا أَوْلَادَكُمْ

And do not kill your children

2. Examples from the Qur'an for: **Emphasis**.

أذْكُرُوا اللَّهَ ذِكْرًا

remember Allah with remembrance

رَتِّلِ الْقُرْآنَ تَرْتِيلًا

and recite the Qur'an with measured recitation

وَكَلَّمَ اللَّهُ مُوسَى تَكْلِيمًا

And Allah spoke to Moses with [direct] speech

3. Examples from the Qur'an for: **Why or for what?**

وَلَا تَقْتُلُوا أَوْلَادَكُمْ خَشْيَةَ إِمْلَاقٍ

And do not kill your children for fear of poverty

يَجْعَلُونَ أَصَابِعَهُمْ فِي آذَانِهِمْ مِنَ الصَّوَاعِقِ حَذَرَ الْمَوْتِ

They put their fingers in their ears against the thunderclaps in dread of death

يُنْفِقُونَ أَمْوَالَهُمْ ابْتِغَاءَ مَرْضَاتِ اللَّهِ

They spend their wealth seeking Allah's Pleasure
