brothers and sisters...







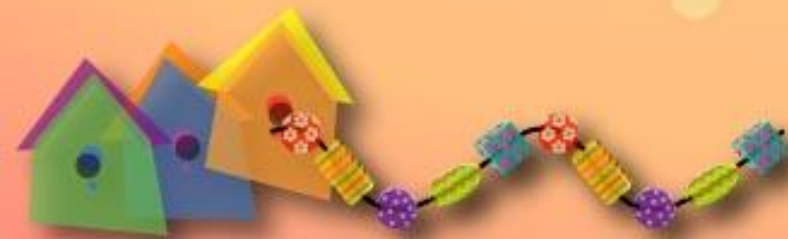
# **We worship**

# We ask for help.

نَسْتَعِينُ (5)	وَإِيَّاكَ
nasta-‘een	wa 'iyyaaka
we ask for help.	and <b>You</b> alone

**O Allah! Without your help, we can not do any thing. We can not worship you.**

**With Your help, everything is possible.**

**Praying on time, studying Qur'an, studying other subjects, listening to parents, teachers, being nice to people, avoiding bad things, ...**
