wal-laa-hil-'a-zzeem	Wal-laa-hi
By Allah, the Great	By Allah.

Lord ... + رَبِّ	Attached/Possessive Pronouns
his Lord رَبِّهِ Rab-bu-hoo	his هِ-هـ ...hee ...hoo
their Lord رَبِّهِمْ Rab-bu-hum	their هُمْ-هَمَّ ...hum ...him
your Lord رَبِّكَ Rab-bu-ka	your ك--- ...ka
your Lord رَبِّكُمْ Rab-bu-kum	your كُمْ--- ...kum
my Lord رَبِّي Rab-bee	my ي--- ...ee
our Lord رَبِّنَا Rab-bu-naa	our نَا--- ...naa
