**II. Spoken Arabic:** Use the three-step-procedure (3SP).

Say the following when (1) you ask for forgiveness of Allah; (2) praising Allah.

	<b>2</b> : سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ	<b>1</b> : أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ	
	Sub-ḥaa-nal-laah	'As-tag-fi-rul-laah	
	Glory be to Allah; Purified is Allah	I ask forgiveness of Allah	

**III. Grammar:** Learn using Total Physical Interaction (TPI): See it; Think it; Say it; Show it; ...

Please note that the preposition لَ comes 1367 times attached with the following 7 pronouns (including هَا). It may also be mentioned that preposition may have other meanings too, when it comes with a verb, etc. It may also be mentioned here that from now onwards we will focus on singular feminine forms only because the rest of the feminine forms are not used extensively in the Qur'an.

for them; their لَهُمْ la-hum	pl.	
for you; your لَكَ la-ka	sr.	2 <sup>nd</sup>

for me; mine لِي lee	sr.	1 <sup>st</sup>
for us; our لَنَا la-na	dl., pl.
