- Jama'at is ready.
- We are about to talk to Allah in prayer.

- Every other activity must come to a complete halt; even our thinking on any other topic.

Allahu 'Akbar:

- Again a reminder. It will be good for us only if we accept the Greatness of Allah by obeying Him. Therefore, stop everything else.

La Ilaha Illallahu:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ

laa 'ilaha 'illal-lah

There is no god except Allah.

- There is none worthy of worship except Allah alone. So, at this time, don't listen to any one except Allah. Just go for prayer.
