After completing this lesson (a & b), you will learn **232 new** words, which occur **41,111** times in the Qur'an.

The short formula for remembering the verb forms (Short conjugation):

and four for فعل ماضِ and 7 forms for فعل مضارع and four for فعل ماضِ. If we pick up

- نَعَل ماضِ the key for all فعل ماضِ forms;
- يَفْعَلُ : the key for all فعل مضارع forms;
- نفعل أمر the key for all إفْعَلُ: the key for all

and add the three nouns فَاعِل، مَفْغُول، فِغَل to it, we get the short table for all the basic forms that are made from فَعَل، مَفْغُول، فِغَل
