separate them to produce the sound**

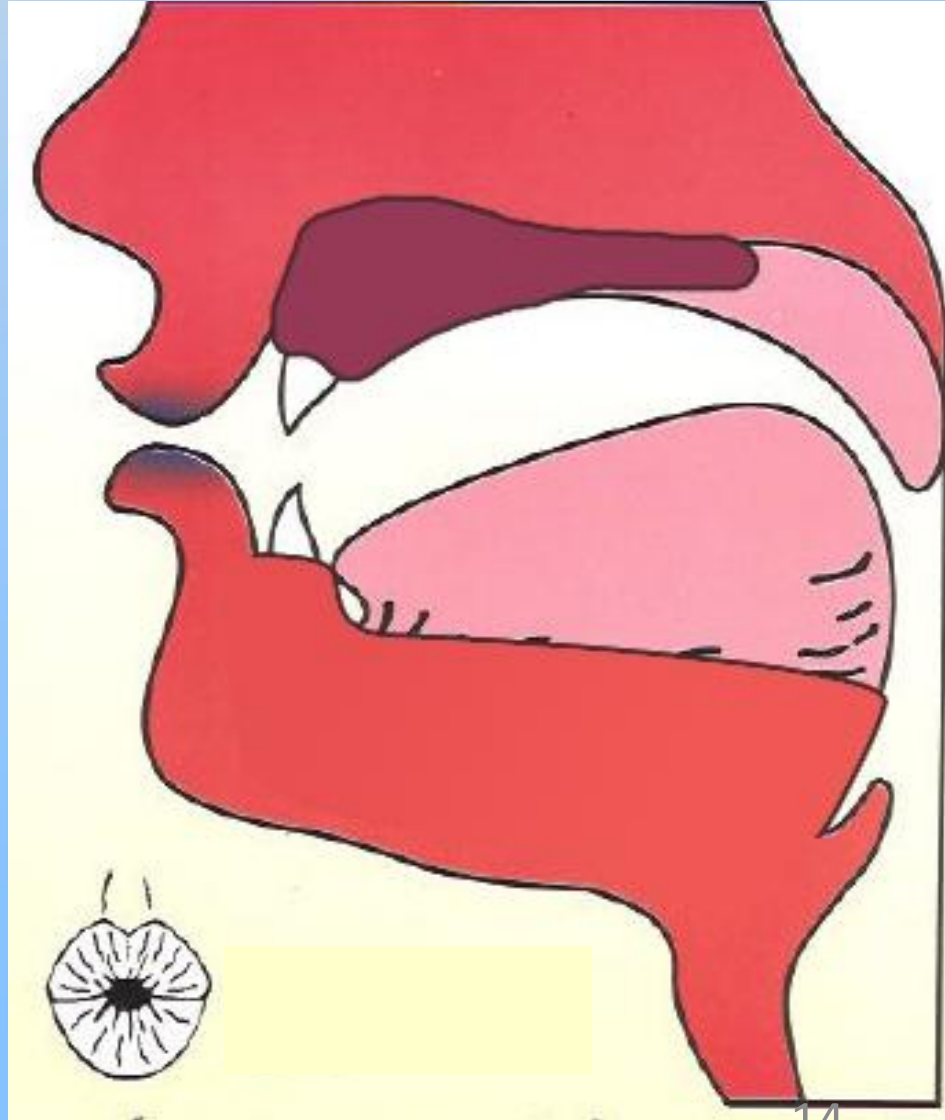
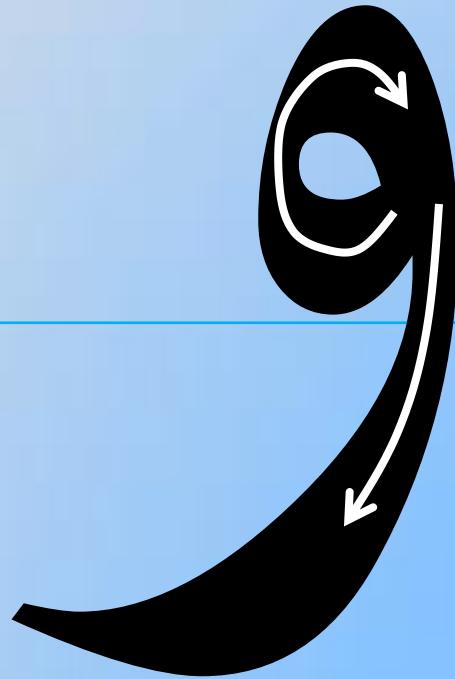
